- Liaison Reports

 - Final budget was presented at the last Board of Education Meeting. A website about the Referendum is live and thoroughly outlines the plan and budget information. Voters will see 3 referendum questions on the ballot, 2 of which are dependent on each other: 1) physical infrastructure & 2) funding for operating within that infrastructure. The 3rd question refers to an upgrade to the Metuchen High School gymnasium and is characterized as a "nice-to-have".

 - Currently working on the development of sensory resources within the borough. Brainstorming ideas on how to make community events more accessible and developing an inclusive yoga class.
 - AARP community conversation was canceled due to lack of public interest.
