Liaison Reports

- Arthur Flaherty (MPD Liaison)
 - Metuchen Police Department is implementing the Safe Place Initiative within the next few months
 - Originated in the Seattle Police Department
 - This is a partnership between the Metuchen Police Department and Metuchen Businesses. Participating businesses will provide a safe place for victims, while help is called. Safe Place empowers victims to report incidents to police so the crime can be properly investigated. This program is free for businesses, who will receive a rainbow shield sticker and training materials at no cost. The goal is to bridge the gap between victims and police. This program says to any victim of Bias or Hate Crime that "You will be heard, you will be treated with care, dignity and respect from the business you enter to find help in, as well as from Law Enforcement Officers from your agency who respond to investigate".
- Dylan Jaques (HS Senior Liaison)
 - Students are pursuing implementation of a DEI suggestion box at Metuchen High School.
- Hazel-Anne Johnson-Marcus (BOE Liaison)
