Sunshine Law Acknowledgement:

Approval of Minutes from the Meetings of May 28 and June 24, 2013.

Program Reports:

- **Gallery Walk:** Amy Brooks reported that the four galleries in town are planning a Gallery Walk on October 13th from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. They are looking for restaurant partners for each gallery. The Arts Council was asked to secure a musician to play outside Borough Hall for a period of time that day. Grace Shackney said she would try to line someone up. Ron Grayzel will ask permission to use the Borough Hall parking lot. The banner for the Rotunda Gallery should be installed outside Borough Hall by that time. It was suggested that the Council send a letter to the Borough Administrator and the Mayor and Council thanking them for the installation of the gallery lighting.
- **Outdoor Movie:** Henry Chang reported that the movie night was held in Oakland Park. It was a beautiful evening. About 150 attended the first feature and 60 stayed for the second feature. Nancy recorded one complaint before the event took place from a park-side resident about the sound levels last year. The complaint was taken into consideration during the set-up this time around. The Borough Improvement League operated a concession stand. The proceeds went to benefit "Break The Chain." The Criterion gave us a free ad for the event.
- **Bus Trip to the Brooklyn Museum:** Nancy reported that the trip sold out the bus with 45 people. We cleared \$150. Kathy Glaser suggested the Council sponsor a fall trip to the Parish Museum in Waterville, Long Island.
- **Metuchen Rocks! Concert Series:** Grace Shackney reported that the bands are in place for performances in the Senior Center parking lot for August 15th, 22nd, 29th and September 1st. Kathy Glaser offered to contact the Parking

- Gallery Report:
 - On September 21st Nails in the Wall Gallery @ St. Luke's will hold an opening reception for the Exhibition, "Spirituality of the Mandela, Reality in the Round" from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Also on that day at 7:00 p.m. Transformations Gallery at the Old Franklin School House will host an opening reception for the exhibit "Catching Up: Friends then, art now."
 - Amy Brooks reported that the four galleries in town are planning a Gallery Walk on October 13th from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. They are looking for restaurant partners for each gallery. The Arts Council was asked to secure a musician to play outside Borough Hall.
- Jazzfest: Jazzfest takes place on the same day as the above mentioned gallery openings on September 21. The performance starts at 3:00 p.m. in the plaza in front of Borough Hall. The program will be held at the Senior Center should it rain. Performing will be the James L. Dean Big Band and jazz vocalist Carrie Jackson and her band. Grace Shackney will tie the Jazzfest to the "Artfest" in our press releases.
- Metuchen Rocks! Concert Series: Grace Shackney reported that we had an excellent turnout for the August 15th concert with the Philadelphia Jazz Orchestra and on August 22 for Eryn Shewell and the Whiskey Devils with between 150 and 200 people for both. Feedback from the audience was very positive for both shows. All is set for the Reggae band Random Test on August 29th and Citizens Band Radio on Sunday, September 1st. Grace urged the Council members to come out and support the concerts.

- DanceSpora Outdoor Dance Program: Grace Shackney reported that DanceSpora is not able to commit to a September date to perform in Metuchen, as they are involved in rehearsals and performances of a new dance piece in Trenton. While they have availability in October, Grace suggested that we put this program on the agenda for next year and book a mutually acceptable date well in advance that we can fully publicize. All present were in agreement.

Budgeting & Programming for 2014

Grace Shackney asked that this item be taken up at our September 23rd meeting. She asked everyone to come to that meeting with programming ideas and budgets. Grace will prepare an overall budget of monies available.
