



MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 24, 2014, 8:00 P.M.
2nd Floor meeting room, Borough Hall

The Metuchen Arts Council meeting on February 24, 2013 was called to order by Chairperson Grace Shackney at 8:05 p.m. Those present were: Linda LaStella, Henry Chang, John Sharp, Grace Shackney, and Ron Grayzel.

Minutes from the January 27th meeting were not available. Since there was not a quorum, no items were approved. However, the following items were discussed:

- Grace distributed 2014 Program Sign Up Sheets and asked that everyone indicate when they were available to help.
- Linda reported that the Gallery Walk will take place on October 19th. The Galleries are asking for the Arts Council support for the printed program and to supply the musicians as we did last year. Linda will find out what the cost of the programs was.
- The Metuchen Country Fair will take place on October 11th.
- The Junebug Artfest Committee has been meeting. A new logo and application forms are under review and expected to be posted. The deadline for artist/performers to apply is April 11th. Then the work of assigning spaces and venues will begin.
- The Art in The Garden Tour is scheduled for June 14th. There are committee slots to be filled for this event.
- The Sheep on Show Art Workshop at the BIL (for which we are a co-sponsor) is scheduled for May 18th.
- The February 23rd Snowflake Concert featuring Preschool of Rock was sold out. There is definitely a demand for children's programming. The last in the series is scheduled for March 23rd with Yosi.
- The Community Mural Project is set to start the tile making workshops every Saturday and Sunday in the first 3 weekends of March. It is very well subscribed to. Council members are asked to sign up to help.
- Scott Gallagher is holding a program for the Princeton Learning Cooperative on alternative education at the Old Franklin School on March 20th and requested the use of our projector.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m. The Arts Council will next meet on March 31st.
