

**METUCHEN MUNICIPAL POOL COMMISSION  
MEETING – FEBRUARY 22, 2016**

The February meeting of the Metuchen Municipal Pool was called to order at 7:30 pm. In attendance were Jonathan Miller, Kathy Stankiewicz, Todd Shaper, Terry Irving, Emily Mertz, Rick Carter and Jeremy Campbell.

The Sunshine Law was read.

The minutes of the December meeting were approved with a motion from Kathy and a second by Todd.

**Office Manager's Report**

The Maintenance Contract is being prepared for bid in March. The e-mail address for Swim and Dive Teams will be added to the Pool Application.

**Pool Manager's Report**

Interviews will take place the third week of March. An informal quote from Greg Gaudet for the painting at the pool was received. The price will be between \$10,000 - \$12,000. Bushes by the pump house need replacing, Aquatic Service has said that in order to upgrade the fountain in the Kiddie Pool it will cost \$30,000 which the Commission does not feel the need that important to warrant spending that amount of money.

**Snack Bar Report**

Jeremy stated that the Manager from last season will be back for the coming season. He feels that three Family Fun Days are what should be planned for and if the season appears that it will support another one it can always be added. The coffee pot and Pretzel warmer that were ordered last year were never received so Diana will check with Becky about obtaining them from this year. Voucher coupons will be distributed to each paying membership; \$10.00 per Family Membership, \$5.00 per Individual Membership and \$2.00 per

**Senior Membership.** These will be numbered and sent to members when their membership payment is received in the finance office.

### **Old Business**

Chairs for member use need to be ordered as well as the replacement covers for the shade umbrellas. Other items mentioned that prices are need for are a Pizza Oven, another freezer and a slushy machine.

### **New Business**
