ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN SPECIFICALLY BLOCK 132, LOTS 10 THROUGH 27, AND LOTS 49 THROUGH 51, COMMONLY KNOWN AS 1 SAFETY PLACE FROM METUCHEN SAFETY COUNCIL, INC. (“METUCHEN EMS”) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW EMERGENCY SERVICES BUILDING AND OUTBUILDING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Borough is in the process of the design and construction of a new Emergency Services Building and Outbuilding Project to be located at 1 Safety Place, Metuchen, New Jersey for among other things a new location for the Metuchen Fire Department and Metuchen EMS; and

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12-5(a) provides that any municipality, by ordinance, may provide for the acquisition of real property by purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Metuchen, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12-5, have determined to acquire and purchase certain real estate, Block 132, Lot 10 through 27, and Lots 49 through 51, commonly known as 1 Safety Place (“the Property”) to be used for municipal purposes for the site of a future Emergency Services Building and Outbuilding in the Borough of Metuchen; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12-5(a)(1), and the Eminent Domain Act of 1971 *N.J.S.A.* 20:3-1 et seq. (the “Eminent Domain Act”) the Borough is authorized to acquire the Property for a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Metuchen Safety Council, Inc. (“Metuchen EMS”) is the owner of the real property located at Block 132, Lots 10 through 27, and Lots 49 through 51 as shown on the tax map of the Borough of Metuchen, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to acquire title to the Property in order to complete the design and construction of the new Emergency Services Building and Outbuilding Project which shall include, among other things, space for the continued operations of the Metuchen Fire Department and the Metuchen EMS; and

WHEREAS, the Metuchen EMS wishes to convey the Property to the Borough of Metuchen in return for, among other things, short-term lease agreements for Metuchen EMS’ continued operations and temporary location/s at the Borough’s costs and expense and a long-term lease agreement between the Metuchen EMS and the Borough of Metuchen that would permit the Metuchen EMS to utilize a portion of the new Emergency Services Building and Outbuilding for its continued operations for a nominal cost to the Metuchen EMS; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Metuchen has discussed the proposed acquisition with the Metuchen EMS and have negotiated and drafted the general terms and conditions of the sale and the Borough's acquisition, entitled "Agreement of Sale Between the Metuchen Safety Council, Inc. and the Borough of Metuchen" ("Agreement of Sale"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Metuchen have determined that the acquisition under the terms and conditions of the Agreement of Sale of the Property is in the best interest of the Borough of Metuchen for its future public use for among other things, the location of the Metuchen Fire Department and the Metuchen EMS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Metuchen hereby authorize the acquisition and purchase of Block 132, Lots 10 through 27, and Lots 49 through 51 on the tax maps of the Borough of Metuchen, commonly known as 1 Safety Place, Metuchen, New Jersey according to the specific terms and condition of the Agreement of Sale negotiated by the Parties; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Borough Council that the Mayor, and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to the execute the Agreement of Sale in the form consistent with the Agreement of Sale on file with the Borough Clerk and in a final form acceptable to the Mayor and Borough Administrator; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Mayor, Borough Clerk, Borough Administrator, and Borough Attorney, and any other Borough officials and employees as directed by the Borough Administrator ("Authorized Persons") are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to carry out all necessary actions in order to effectuate and comply with the terms and provisions of the Agreement of Sale, and to take all other necessary action and execute any required documents in order to effect the purchase and acquisition and transfer of title of the Property to the Borough of Metuchen; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Mayor, Borough Clerk, Borough Administrator, and Borough Attorney, and any other Borough officials and employees as directed by the Borough Administrator ("Authorized Persons") are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to negotiate, enter into such further lease agreements for a nominal amount with the Metuchen EMS for its continued location at 1 Safety Place until such time it is necessary for the Borough to take possession of the Property and for the temporary location/s of the Metuchen EMS' operations and for the Long Term Lease Agreement with the Metuchen EMS for Metuchen EMS to utilize a portion of the new Emergency Services Building and Outbuilding upon its completion for its continued operations for a nominal cost to the Metuchen EMS; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that any and all actions previously taken by the Authorized Persons in connection with the purchase and acquisition of the Property are hereby ratified and confirmed; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies and should any section, clause, sentence or provision of any item in this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a

Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, on or October 24, 2022, the Borough of Metuchen adopted Ordinance 2022-19, which allowed for, *inter alia*, three (3) Class 5 Cannabis Retail License to operate within certain locations within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-19 also provided that in order to operate a Class 5 Retail Cannabis establishment, a license must be issued by the Borough Council, as well as the State of New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-19 also set forth the local process to obtain a conditional license to be issued by the Borough Council, Ordinance 2022-19 (Section § 72-7(A)), provided for the issuance of a Request for Proposals and for the public advertisement for applicants seeking a license to submit an application for review and consideration; Section § 72-7(D) authorized the creation of a Cannabis Subcommittee which is to review submissions and/or proposals for any cannabis license and issue a Letter of Endorsement to the successful candidate/s who are required to meet a minimum score; Thereafter, the candidate/s who are issued a Letter of Endorsement are entitled to proceed with an application to the appropriate Land Use Board for their review and consideration; and upon receiving the appropriate land use approval, the applicants are forwarded to the Borough Council for the review and approval of a conditional municipal license; and

WHEREAS, at the February 13, 2023 Mayor and Council meeting, the members of the Cannabis Subcommittee, not specifically designated in Ordinance 2022-19, were appointed; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2023, the Borough of Metuchen issued and advertised a Request for Class 5 Cannabis Retail Business Applications (“RFA”) which provided for responses to be provided by April 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Borough received seven (7) responses from interested entities, including a response from Dasco Solutions, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Cannabis Subcommittee reviewed and evaluated the responses pursuant to the criteria established in the RFA and reported its findings to the Mayor and Council on May 22, 2023; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated May 18, 2023, the Cannabis Subcommittee issued its Letter of Endorsement to Dasco Solutions in order for Dasco Solutions to proceed to file an application with the Planning Board for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, Dasco Solutions filed an application with the Planning Board for review and consideration for Preliminary and Final Major Site Plan Approval, conditional use approval and waiver of submission requirements; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution dated January 5, 2024, the Planning Board of the Borough of Metuchen granted Dasco Solutions Preliminary and Final Site Plan Approval, conditional use approval and waiver of submission requirements subject to various terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No 2022-19, Dasco Solutions has requested the Borough of Metuchen and its Council provide Dasco a Resolution of Support endorsing Dasco Solutions' application for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail License to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission along with the required zoning certification letter; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Metuchen have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to adopt a Resolution of Support endorsing Dasco Solutions' application for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail License to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission and the issuance of a conditional municipal license subject to its compliance with all of the terms, conditions and requirements of the Planning Board Resolution, Redevelopment Plan, and Redevelopment Agreement, all local ordinances and receipt of all necessary approvals to conduct operations therefore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that the Borough hereby approves a conditional municipal license for a Class 5 Cannabis Retail Establishment to Dasco Solutions subject to its compliance with all of the terms, conditions and requirements of the Planning Board Resolution, Redevelopment Plan, and Redevelopment Agreement, all local ordinances and receipt of all necessary approvals to conduct operations therefore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that the Borough supports the Dasco Solutions Class 5 Cannabis Retail License application to the Cannabis Regulatory Commission, subject to its compliance with all of the terms, conditions and requirements of the Planning Board Resolution, Redevelopment Plan, and Redevelopment Agreement, all local ordinances and receipt of all necessary approvals to conduct operations therefore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that the Council is satisfied with Dasco's proposed business location contained in its application to the Borough as suitable for its proposed cannabis retail activities, subject to its compliance all of the terms, conditions and requirements of the Planning Board Resolution, Redevelopment Plan, and Redevelopment Agreement, all local ordinances and receipt of all necessary approvals to conduct operations therefore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that Dasco Solutions ability to operate its proposed cannabis retail business is subject to: (1) Dasco Solutions' receipt of a Class 5 Cannabis Retail License from the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission;

and (2) Dasco Solutions' compliance with all of the terms, conditions and requirements of the Planning Board Resolution, Redevelopment Plan, and Redevelopment Agreement, all local ordinances and receipt of all necessary approvals to conduct operations therefore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Metuchen that it hereby authorizes the Mayor, Borough Administrator, and any other employees and/or officials to take any action necessary to effectuate this Resolution, including but not limited to the issuance of the appropriate Zoning Certification pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.8(a)(4).
