This hard-hitting Blues, Funk and R&B ensemble features the vocals of Ms. Yolanda Briggs. Her soulful renderings of R&B classics make her the undisputed Queen the NJ blues scene.

Sitting on "the Court" with Ms. Briggs will be guitarists Moon Reubin and Tony Scardaci; drummer, Ron Howden (from Nektar); bassist Dave Carta; saxophonist Dave Homan; and the big Blues harp sound of Nancy Swarbrick.

"Big Nancy" is a world-class blues harmonica player who has appeared with many of blues and rock greats including Willie Dixon, Pinetop Perkins, Clarence Clemons, Levon Helm and David Johansen.

The free concert take place on Thursday, August 6th at 7:30 p.m. on the Metuchen Summer Stage located on the corner of New and Center Streets in downtown Metuchen.

There is plenty of free parking. In the event of rain, the concerts will be held inside the Metuchen Senior Center at the same location.
