



An Important Update from Middlesex Water Company





Dear Metuchen Resident:

Crews are working methodically to complete sections of Middlesex Water Company's Western Transmission Main being installed from Jersey Avenue in Metuchen to Cedar Lane in Edison Township. Under this project, expected to be completed and the main in operation by 2020, 4.5 miles of large ductile iron pipe (42-inches in diameter) is being constructed to provide critical back-up water supply in Metuchen and surrounding towns. As the project proceeds, streets will be affected for a period of time. We apologize for this inconvenience and are working diligently with the Borough and local traffic authorities to minimize impact along the route as much as possible. This is one of the most significant infrastructure undertakings in Middlesex Water's 121-year old history and the \$52 million investment will help ensure greater reliability, safety and service quality to current and future generations of water consumers throughout eastern Middlesex County.
