- Paper must be in a manageable container- No Plastic Bags.
- No need to remove paper clips, staples or paperboard binder covers.
- Do Not Bring: Newspapers, magazines, hardcover books, junk mail, photos, x-rays, CDs, shredded paper or garbage.
- Loads containing unacceptable items may be rejected.
- Residential Paper Only – **No Businesses Allowed.**

Residents must wear face coverings, keep their vehicle windows closed and stay in their vehicles at all times. Please have your materials in your trunk, cargo area or truck bed, easily accessible to our staff, who will remove it from your vehicle.
